An interview is not considered recoverable data, so no reference to this is provided in the reference list. You may, however, cite the interview within the text as a personal communication. Examples: (J. Smith, personal communication, August 15, 2009) J. Smith (personal communication, August 15, 2009)

How do you cite an interview? (6th edition) - APA Style

Elements of the reference. Not included in reference list. In-text reference: Do not cite individually, because this could compromise confidentiality. Quote anonymously, for example, "Participant A said". Reference list: Do not include in the reference list. EndNote reference type: Not included in reference list. <<

The sixth edition provides explicit rules for direct quotations and states that you must credit the source when "paraphrasing, quoting an author directly, or describing an idea that influenced your work" (p. 170). If the quotation is less than 40 words, incorporate the quotation into the text and place quotation marks round the quotation.
